

MASTER FITTER ASSESSMENT - CARPET

OVERVIEW OF PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT

Training Centre assessment

You will be expected to install a secondary backed plain carpet to a hallway incorporating a join, small landing, three winders and a bull nosed step. You will also be required to produce a small join to a felt backed carpet.

You will be required to bring with you your own van and all necessary tools to complete the task.

All materials and accessories will be provided, however feel free to bring along any additional supplies you feel you may need.

Tea, coffee and cold drinks will be supplied.

On-site assessment

You will be required to use your own van to take the assessor to the installation and must have your own tools on the van so that they can be assessed (the tools that you require to install carpets).

Prior to the assessment you will be required to submit names and addresses to send out reference documents which must be returned prior to an assessment date being set.

You will be assessed on your personal presentation (acceptable appearance viewed from a customer aspect), your tools (sufficient tools to carry out the task) and your van (appearance, tidiness suitable to carry all materials without damage).

Verbal questions asked by the assessor. The questions are set so that we can assess your knowledge on the areas that cannot be covered in the practical or onsite assessment. They will be based on general knowledge relating to the installation of carpets. These will include questions on woven carpets and subfloor preparation.

The assessor will need to see a flat area with a join and a hall stairs and landing with a bullnose and winding steps, all fitted on a stretch fit installation.

You will be required to take up small sections of the installation so that the assessor can see the preparation.
