

MASTER FITTER ASSESSMENT – WOOD

OVERVIEW OF PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT

You will be required to install wood flooring to a room setting approximately 1.70m x 2.40m.

Your tasks are to plywood the sub floor, skim a separate sub floor, install wood plank to the area prepared with the plywood -50% glued, 50% nailed - and to finish with scotia/skirting.

You will be required to bring your own tools (tools that you require to install Wood Floors) and come in your van. All materials will be provided including:- Plywood, Skim, Adhesive, Scotia/Skirting. If you think you require any additional supplies or materials you are familiar with, please feel free to bring your own supplies.

You will be assessed on your personal presentation (acceptable appearance viewed from a customer aspect), your tools (sufficient tools to carry out the task) and your van (appearance, tidiness suitable to carry all materials without damage).

Verbal questions asked by the assessor. The questions are set so that we can assess your knowledge on the areas that cannot be covered in the practical assessment. They will be based on general knowledge relating to the installation of Wood Floors. These will include questions on wood types and sub-floor preparation.

You will be assessed on: -

- Plywood correctly cut and fixed.
- Skim mixed and applied correctly.
- Setting out of wood floor.
- Alignment of Wood to the area.
- Correct amount of fixings.
- Correct application of adhesive.
- Undercutting of architraves.
- Wood tightly fitted together.
- Skirtings/Scotia correctly fitted.
- Safe Working conditions.
